Esperanza Adventure

This two-day adventure now includes overnight accommodation in Zeballos or Tahsis and makes stops en route to deliver passengers and freight as required. Your voyage begins in Gold River and travels the waterways of Nootka Sound to the Village of Tahsis where overnight passengers will disembark. From there the MV Uchuck III will follow Tahsis Narrows into Zeballos Inlet and eventually Zeballos where remaining passengers will disembark and the ship will spend the night. Both Tahsis and Zeballos offer guests quality accommodations, services including restaurants and plenty of activities for the outdoor enthusiast. This trip may also include a stop at Friendly Cove on Tuesdays to pick up passengers.

Friendly Cove Day Trip

During the summer months the M.V. Uchuck III provides day trips to Friendly Cove, ancestral home of the Mowachaht/Muchalaht people. Rich in Native and European history, Friendly Cove (Yuquot) was first visited by Captain James Cook in 1778. There he traded with Chief Maquinna for otter furs. Today Friendly Cove offers its visitors campgrounds, hiking trails and tours.

Kyuquot Adventure

This trip takes you through Nootka Sound, up Tahsis Inlet and out Esperanza Inlet to the ocean. From there you travel along the West Coast to Kyuquot Sound where the trip ends at the settlement of Kyuquot located on the inside of Walter's Island. Along the way the ship goes about her work of delivering supplies and passengers to logging camps and settlements. You may see the annual migration of Grey whales in early spring or a few of the resident Greys at any time. There can be bears on the beaches, sea otters and occasional killer whales in the ocean and a multitude of birds in the air.
